Same way, in February 2026, our School quiz team consisting of 6 members from classes IV to VII led by Debashree Chakroborty attended Inter school Quiz competition held at Natrodum Academy, NTPC Salakati in which our students bagged the runners up in junior category and 3rd prize in Senior category.

SPORTS:

A friendly football match was organised against CNL Bengtol in the month of April under the leadership of Sports In charge Anand Basumatary where our students played well and won the match same way against Delhi Public School,Dhaligaon. One more Football ball match was organised where our team won easily against DPS Dhaligaon . Our basketball team also played a friendly match against JNV Kokrajhar.

One student of Standard IX, TANMOY BARMAN won upto the quarter Finals at the 24th Junior National Wushu Championship 2025 held in Telangana.The student also secured the Gold Medal in below 85Kg category in XXII in junior all Assam Inter district Wushu Championship 2025 held at DTRP Indoor stadium Guwahati, on 13-14 May 2025.

In the Month of November 2025, on 3rd and 4th along with **school's 9th Foundation day** on 31st October 2025 – there was first ever Interschool Sports Carnival of three Events, Football boys, Basketball both boys and Girls and also Volleyball for both boys and girls. We had sent the invitation to three neighbouring district schools of Bongaigaon, Chirang and Kokrajhar. Near about 14 schools have participated in the Sports Carnival. Our school computer lab has been updated with Server computer in which three batches of class III, V and IX attended CBSE SAFAL assessment digitally in the month of November 2025. The new basketball field court has been developed along with appointment of basketball Coach Wusu Sanda/ Yoga room has been developed so that students can freely develop their skill in those field. New Football coach has been appointed and made him residential so that every evening he can monitor the games and after school sports coaching of the students. Near about 50-60 boys and girls both from hostel and day scholar are regularly attending dedicated sports coaching every day. Same way a new school bus Of 40-seater was introduced in the month of August in the fleet of school bus for the students.
